

STUDENT AT LARGE PROGRAM

About the Program

The Student at Large (SAL) Program is sponsored by the Chicago Institute for Psychoanalysis. The Program was developed to give people with a serious interest in psychoanalysis the opportunity to take courses taught by an experienced psychoanalyst as well as some courses in the Psychoanalytic Education Program. The SAL Program gives people from various backgrounds an introduction to psychoanalysis and the opportunity to develop their knowledge and understanding about psychoanalytic theory and practice. One of the goals of the SAL Program is to demonstrate the value of psychoanalytic ideas to a larger proportion of the population.

- *All classes are taught by members of the faculty of The Chicago Institute for Psychoanalysis*
- *Students are permitted to take a maximum of 2 courses in any quarter*
- *Students must receive instructor permission for each course prior to enrolling*

WHO ARE THE STUDENTS AT LARGE?

CLINICIANS:

- Clinicians who are considering the Psychoanalytic Education Program (PEP), the Adult Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy Program (APP) or the Child and Adolescent Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy Training Program (CAPPT), but are not ready to commit to the rigors of full training.
- Clinicians who wish to gain a deeper understanding of psychoanalytic ideas and practice to use in treatment with their patients, but are not planning on full psychoanalytic training.
- Graduates of APP or CAPPT who wish to continue their education and affiliation with the Chicago Institute for Psychoanalysis
- Students in clinical PhD or PsyD programs or in clinical Master's programs with an interest in psychoanalytic theory and clinical process who may wish to seek admission to Institute programs in the future

NON-CLINICIANS:

- Academicians, researchers and scholars in related fields who teach in university settings who wish to deepen their understanding of psychoanalytic theory and clinical process to assist their teaching and research programs
- Individuals with non-clinical Master's degrees who have a serious interest in psychoanalysis
